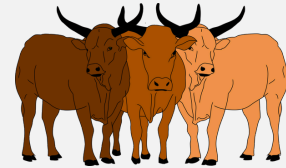


COLLECTIVE NOUNS

A Collective Noun is a word that means a group of people, animals, or things.

Instead of saying “many cows,” we say “a herd of cows.”

This one word tells us about the whole group.



Group	Collective Noun	Easy Sentence
Many students	class	Our class is learning English.
Many birds	flock	A flock of birds is flying in the sky.
Many cows	herd	A herd of cows is in the field.
Many flowers	bunch	I gave mom a bunch of flowers.
Many toys	pile	I saw a pile of toys in the room.
Many players	team	Our team won the football game.
