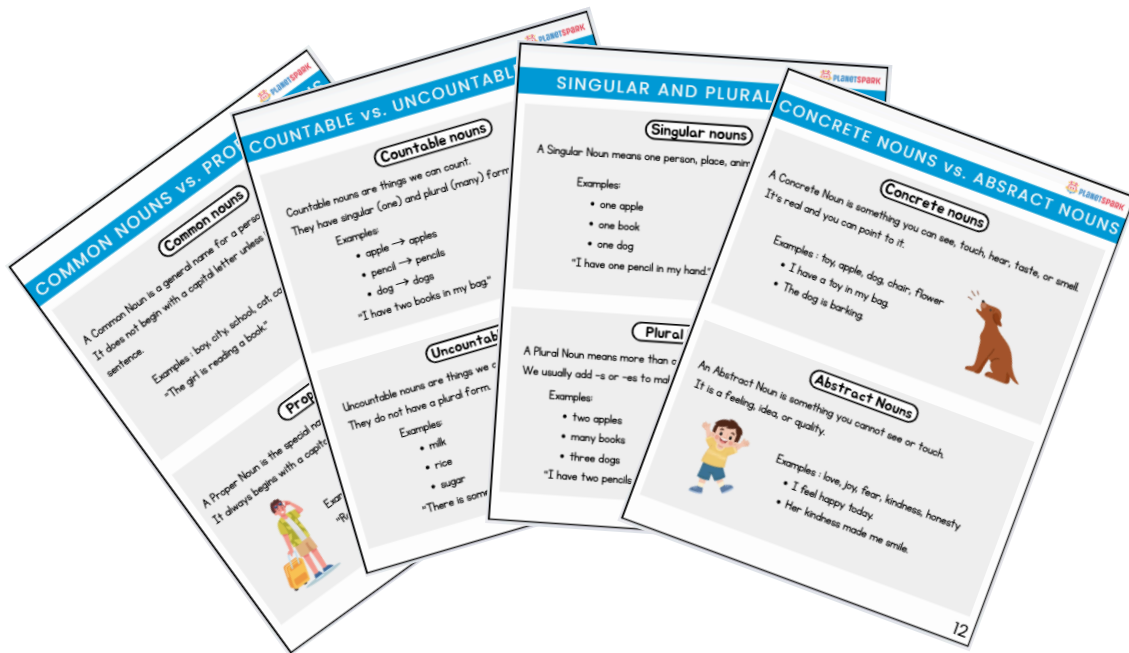

ABSTRACT-CONCRETE NOUNS

Concrete nouns

A Concrete Noun is something you can see, touch, hear, taste, or smell. It's real and you can point to it.

Examples : toy, apple, dog, chair, flower

- I have a toy in my bag.
- The dog is barking.



Abstract Nouns

An Abstract Noun is something you cannot see or touch. It is a feeling, idea, or quality.



Examples : love, joy, fear, kindness, honesty

- I feel happy today.
- Her kindness made me smile.
