#### 1. Forms

- Subject Pronouns: I, you, he, she, it, we, they
- Object Pronouns: me, you, him, her, it, us, them

#### 2. Persons

- 1st Person → Speaker (I, me, we, us)
- 2nd Person → Listener (you)
- 3rd Person → Others (he, him, she, her, it, they, them)

#### 3. Usage

- Subject pronouns = Do the action (e.g., She runs)
- Object pronouns = Receive the action (e.g., I saw him)
